While offering our best wishes to you in your endeavors of taking the university to greater heights, we wish to bring to your kind notice for necessary action the under mentioned issues which need immediate attention.

1. At present, BBM and BCA courses are considered as professional courses and the students are charged high registration and examination fees. In fact, they are on

par with any other degree course like B.Com/B.Sc/B.A. The disparity should be rectified.

2. There is a general declining trend in the admission to humanities courses. By taking advantage of this phenomenon, some managements are closing down such courses. Affiliated colleges should not be allowed to discontinue courses in humanities.
3. The maximum strength in any course per section should not exceed 80.
4. There are many practical difficulties for teachers in attending the Ph.D course work as organized by the university. There is an urgent need to simplify the process.
5. Please follow up the memorandum already submitted by AMUCT on May 8, 2014 with regard to revising the examination related remuneration comprehensively.
