

Here there is a need to be circumspect and restraint is desirable before they take a call. Any attempt to bartend a half-baked dishes will squarely defeat the objective. The gnawing issues have to be thrashed out with well meaning people joining party. The educational institutions should play a proactive role in this regard. It is the responsibility of all the stakeholders to effect the changes and evolutionary change is enduring than revolutionary change. When push comes to shove, the customary mud raking has to be jettisoned and collusion should be the watchword.

It is heartening that the famed university of ours has leapt forward with the NEP. The Hon. Vice Chancellor is vivacious and exudes confidence in reaching the shores with his choice statement- 'Reforms with little tears'. We, the teaching fraternity have to adapt to the new dispensation, adopt the new system and be adept at making it a practical proposition.

As the president of AMUCT I place on record the contribution of all the members in making it a successful entity. I also place on record the support and cooperation given to us by the FUCTAK.

May the success story repeat year after year.

Knowledge is extolled by everyone; it is considered great everywhere; one can attain everything with the help of knowledge; a wise and knowledgeable person is respected everywhere.

Education today has become a fundamental aspect of our lives. It helps in the creation of a better society and encourages innovation and creativity. Higher education aims at producing engaged, productive and containing citizens for building an equitable, inclusive and plural society as envisaged by our constitution. Higher education gives a person an opportunity to succeed in today's global economy.

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 was approved by the Government of India in July 2020 which outlined a vision for a completely new, globalised education system in the country. NEP 2020 document begins with the slogan; "Education is fundamental for achieving full human potential, developing an equitable and just society, and promoting national development. Providing universal access to quality education is the key to India's continued ascent and leadership on the global stage in terms of economic growth, social justice and equality, scientific advancement, national integration, and cultural preservation."

The previous National Education Policy was approved by the Government of India in 1986. So, after 36 years, with lots of hopes, the NEP 2020 is prepared and approved by the Government of India to bring its education on par with the rest of the world.

It was a proud moment for the higher education system in Karnataka state for introducing the NEP 2020 first time in India since 2021. The key changes that the NEP in Karnataka are doing away with the triple-major system prevalent in the state, creating multiple entries and exit points for students, making degrees four years long instead of the previous three years, making Kannada a compulsory language and introducing a significant research component in the fourth year.

Now we are in the second year of its NEP system. Even though the concept of NEP 2020 is good there are diverse opinions regarding its implementation. Because of the confusion in



the interpretation of the NEP 2020, the admission for the first year degree has affected drastically. Most of the colleges got fewer admissions this year despite achieving the good results in Pre-University education. This is because creating an atmosphere of apprehension about the future of graduate education. To set right this confusion it is everyone's duty to hold a dialogue between the concerned faculty organization, students and universities and fix the derailed graduate education.

The editorial committee records the achievements of AMUCT during 2021-22 under the leadership of Dr. Joseph N.M. President, Dr.Vishala B.K. General Secretary and all other office bearers. I thank all the contributors of articles to this issue and also the Madhuban Graphics, Mangalore for printing the issue so nicely. I welcome your valuable feedback on this issue which will be helpful to us in bringing out the next AMUCT Bulletin.

- He extended a welcome to the members, read out the agenda of the meeting and it was approved by the house.
- The President in his initial remarks expressed his unhappiness regarding the response of
 the Convenors to the MCM. He stressed that it's the convenors bound duty and
 responsibility to attend the MCM and convey the proceedings to their respective college
 AMUCT members. Members those who were present also felt that a strong message
 should be sent to the convenors through the WhatsApp group.

The minutes of the Second Managing Council Meeting of AMUCT for the year 2021-22 held on Saturday 20th August, 2022 at 3.00 P.M. in the AMUCT Office, Nithyananda Complex, Kodialbail, Mangaluru- 575003.

15 members were present.

- The President Dr. Joseph N. M. called the meeting to order,
- He extended a warm welcome to the members, read out the agenda of the meeting and it was approved by the house.
- The President in his initial remarks briefed the house that the AMUCT has a great image and with cordial relationship with the higher officials at Mangalore University, AMUCT could succeed in achieving its goal in certain areas.
- He brought to the notice of the members that, the Govt. is insisting to follow the 'Uniform Academic Calendar', 16th is the last date for admission and to start the classes for the first years on the 17th of August 2022.
- AMUCT was involved in various meetings conducted by the Mangalore University and convinced the higher authorities to fix the date for opening i.e. September 1st for the first-degree students.
- University is worrying to start even on September 1st, since the BCM hostel starts only in October and the students can not afford to spend for their stay outside, he said.
- President informed the house that Prof.V. Ravindrachary, Department of Physics from Mangalore University was suggesting AMUCT to educate P.U. students that degree courses are not for 4 years instead it's for three years. Parents have the wrong notion that the degree will be given after four years.
- Regarding receiving arrears, President brought to the notice of the members that, this
 year's Uniform struggle fund was not collected because there was varied category of
 arrears receivers.
- He also raised objection with the Joint Director about questioning the NAAC Accreditation status of the college and pointed out that all colleges are seriously working on the SSR and other documents related to NAAC.
- President placed on record the selfless service rendered by Sri Ganesh Pai for releasing the salary and arrears.



- He also placed on record the generous service rendered by Mr.Dheeraj S.M. in renovating the washroom and clearing the issues related to water.
- The minutes of the 1st Meeting of the Managing Council Meeting held on 4th June, 2022 for the year 2021-22 were read out by the secretary and it was approved by the house.
- Regarding approval of expenses incurred from April to June 2022, Mr.Gopal M.Gokhale, Treasurer presented an account and it was approved by the house.

 - Resolved to request the Govt. to extend the Old Pension Scheme instead of NPS to all employees.
 - Resolved to request the Govt. to Regularize Principals in Aided Colleges.
 - Resolved to urge the Govt. for the creation of Professors' posts and fill the same in Aided Colleges also.
 - Resolved to urge the Govt. to sanction Ph.D. increments to the teachers who have completed their Ph.D Degree after 2015.
 - Resolved to request the Govt. to extend the RUSA grant to the Aided Colleges also.
 - Resolved to request the Govt. to bear the share of the Pension of employees of Aided Colleges also as in the Govt. College.
 - · Resolved to request the University for the Standardization of the pay scale to the management staff
 - Resolved to urge the University to remunerate the Principals of all the Colleges for discharging the Chief Examiners and Custodians' duty during the examination and valuation.
 - Resolved to urge the University to consider an unaided combination for Grant-in-aid.

- The President Dr. Joseph N.M. called the meeting to order, extended a welcome, and read the agenda.
- The General Secretary, Dr. Vishala B K, presented the proceedings of the 34th Annual General Body Meeting held at St Agnes College, (Autonomous), Mangaluru on January 2021. It was approved by the House
- The General Secretary, Dr. Vishala B K. also presented the Annual Report of the Association for the year 2020 -21.
- The Treasurer, Mr. Gopal M Gokhale, presented the Audited Accounts of the Association for the year 2020 -21 and Budget for the year 2021-22. Certain clarifications were sorted out by the members. 



Remembering Norbert

On October 16, 2022, Norbert, his wife Anita, and I had breakfast in the hospital room which never gave me any hint that it was my last breakfast with him in this world. Time is cruel and harsh. I have never thought that Norbert's end would come so fast and unexpectedly, which made me feel lost and directionless. I don't know how much time I may require to come out from this agony. Even though his health failed him, he had never expressed any difficulty till the last moment of his life with us, his friends. When I raised a surprise toast for his golden birthday at the rooftop of the Medha Apartments, I reminded him that he had a second fifty to complete but my presumption went wrong and I lost a friend. With that ended a 46 years long interaction with him as a classmate, friend and counselor with whom I could share my thoughts and ideas and debate any issue at any point of time.

I have seen his tremendous growth at the intellectual level after his college days. During his postgraduate studies, I have observed him very seriously studying in the library from morning till the closure of the library every day. He never stopped learning. Immediately after his Master's, enrolled for M.Phil and later completed PhD studies while in service at St Aloysius College. The hunger for knowledge he had developed at that stage continued till his last breath. This hunger elevated him as one of the known economic scholars of the coastal region. He has brought out several standard Research publications either independently or along with his teacher Prof. G. V. Joshy. It also gave him the confidence to guide his students to pursue their Ph D studies. However, he never remained as an economist of only intellectuals. He has also made efforts to explain economics in simple terms to the student community by publishing a good number of textbooks on various topics in economics even though it was a time-consuming and economically less privileged activity.

I had several occasions to witness his leadership qualities during his life journey. He was the president of the Catholic Youth Movement, a youth wing of the parish level at his native place in Moodubelle. He used to make a thorough preparation for the meetings. He also made a rule that whatever the discussion or debate that takes place in the meeting should not be carried away by the members as their personal defeat or victory outside the meeting. After the heated arguments in the meeting we used to go together to the nearby hotel for refreshments and sit together to share eateries which he had continued during his Presidentship of AMUCT. He was an innovator, In Moodubelle he came up with an idea of Parish Bulletin while in AMUCT, he had proposed a website for the Association. The Bulletin of the Parish and the Website of AMUCT continued without any hindrance till today.

In the year 2012 he was elected as the President of the Association of Mangalore University College Teachers (AMUCT). He took up this responsibility with much resistance because he knew that it was



not an easy task for which he had to make a lot of sacrifices. However, once he was convinced to take up the leadership, he had raised AMUCT to new standards. It was his initiative to host the Annual Convention of the All India Federation of University and College Teachers' Organisations (AIFUCTO) in a small town like Mangalore which accommodated more than 2000 delegates from all over the country. It was not an easy task, for him. He had to spend sleepless nights which also affected his health. The Annual Convention brought him fame at the national level and he was elected the Vice President of AIFUCTO which made him travel to different places of the country to attend the meetings and contribute to the teachers movement at national level. He was recognised as "Loboji' a prominent leader at National level. However, he did not continue it after his term ended due to health reasons even though there was pressure on him to take more responsibility at national level.

After joining St Aloysius College, as a young lecturer, he came into contact with a few senior teaching staff who encouraged young lecturers to make use of their holidays in training the children and youth of different parishes on leadership qualities, career guidance and motivational talks. Norbert took up this agenda as his mission and continued it till the end of his life. He has concentrated more on career guidance and collected almost all information on the topic. He was known as an 'expert' in career choice. Thousands of students benefited from his career guidance talks. Parents personally visited him along with their wards to get the knowledge of newly emerging courses and possibilities of job opportunities after graduation. His expertise has been used by the Church on various occasions. The changing socio-economic situation which led to the change in value system and religious approaches prompted the leaders of the community to have more discussions on the burning topics. Norbert was invited to share his ideas on such discussions at Shimoga, Udupi, and Bangalore diocesan level.

At St Aloysius College, he was a well disciplined professor. Everyday he used to prepare for his classes. He never entered the class without any preparation even after 30 years of his service. Students used to appreciate his knowledge and always wanted to learn from him. He had the great dream to raise the subject of economics to a greater level. It was his initiative to start the Post Graduate department of Economics at St Aloysius, which he had led in the initial years of its inception. He also initiated the Economics paper in BSc along with Mathematics and Statistics. He volunteered himself to teach the new subject for BSc students till his last. He was the only few among the economics faculty who could teach econometrics in the coastal districts.

His native village, Moodubelle in Udupi district, is always proud of him. When he was in school, he actively participated in annual school day dramas. He entertained the villagers as a comedian. In 1980's very few boys and girls graduated from the village and Norbert's graduation, postgraduate and doctorate was viewed by his native people with pride and happiness. They were always delighted when they found his name in the media on one or the other occasion. In recent years his visits to native place were rare and therefore every time I visit, they inquire about him: ನೊಬ್ಬ ಕಸೊ ಆಸಾ? ವಿಚಾರ್ಲಾಂ



ಮಣ್ ಸಾಂಗ್ (How is Norbert? Convey our regards). Perhaps, I may miss that expression to convey to him.

It is specifically a difficult and painful time for his family. He always loved his family. In fact, he had an extended family of his friends with whom he always enjoyed and relaxed. His love for his wife and children was unconditional. Even though he was an expert in career counseling, he gave his children freedom to choose the career of their choice. His family always strongly supported him for his extraordinary work that he was involved in public life. He had also inculcated a strong value system in the family so that they would remain strong throughout with or without him.

Norbert faced the challenges of life with great courage. He has shown path for all of us how to work through challenging circumstances. His commitment to duty, responsibility for the community, concern for fellow teachers, hunger for knowledge and sharing the knowledge with the needy and above all remaining a good human being will inspire the generations to come. He deserves public recognition.
