D increment fiasco, pending arrears etc, have been solved. AMUCT salutes the dynamic and sincere leadership and teacher friendly attitude of these three distinguished persons. I also appreciate profusely the efforts of our State Federation led by our own eminent former president of AMUCT Prof. A.M. Narahari.

In many occasions, it is painful to note that our own colleagues- members of college teaching fraternity - occupying positions of authority and power as a matter of seniority and becoming administrators, fail to respond to the basic and routine needs of teachers. May I expect the examples of the top trio of higher education in Karnataka to be a model to our teacher administrators? May I also

expect them to move forward shunning bureaucracy, red-tapism, and corruption and be proactive and sensitive to teacher issues? Members of AMCUT have always demonstrated high degree of academic excellence, professional ethics and efficient work culture living up to the expectations of all the stake holders. Hope, the trend set by the distinguished top officials is emulated by others particularly, the teacher administrators in the department to facilitate the teachers to fully focus on teaching and research.

Before I sign off, it is very disturbing to note that Mangalore University, *which always claimed itself as a **university with a difference***, is in news for all the wrong reasons these days. The alleged tampering of marks of L.L.B. students at the tabulation level and subsequent doubts raised, regarding the sanctity of examination procedures of BBM and B.Com courses, if true, is a matter of grave concern and absolute disgrace. I call upon, all the stake holders to take up these issues and pressurise the authorities to speed up the inquiry and if proved, punish the guilty at the earliest. Again, mushrooming of colleges without bare basic infrastructure, obtaining affiliation and approval from the university worries all those who have a concern for the quality and sustainability of higher education. *Caesar's wife should be above suspicion*. Mangalore University authorities- are you listening?

## Of Aspirations and Commitments...



The recent months have witnessed elections in the world's largest democracy and examinations in schools and colleges. It is often remarked that in our country democracy is equated with elections and education with examinations. The dust of the elections has settled down and a stable government is in place at the centre – thanks for the ingenuity of the electorate for putting on hold the nightmare of coalition governments at least for this term!

While the elections and examinations were in progress, Mangalore University had the inglorious distinction of the tabulation scam surfacing. The nexus of teachers and officials involved in the racket needs to be exposed and a speedy trial is the need of the hour. AMUCT, as you are aware, took the issue of malpractice in tabulation work seriously and is monitoring the same with the university authorities. College teachers involved in the episode will not be shown any 'soft corner' and their involvement, in the first place, is a matter of shame, to say the least.

While the tabulation issue made news in our region, education is very much in the news at the national level. The HRD Ministry's 100-days plan which includes measures to revamp school education has invited praise as well as criticism. Doing away with Board exams has some merit and alternative evaluation systems need to be worked out. The Yashpal Committee Report pointing out the malaise of capitation fees is only highlighting an already known malady of our system. The unauthorized capitation fees charged by our profit-making educational institutions make education unaffordable to the otherwise eligible poor students.

We as teachers at the university level, bogged down as we are in our individual ‘cases’ and issues, and waiting anxiously for the UGC scales to materialize, need to reflect on our own professional self and the contradictions of education in this country. Are we constantly upgrading ourselves by reading at least, not to say of browsing on the net? Are we quality conscious and making efforts to fine tune our delivery in the classrooms to replace the monotony of our lectures?

A mere glimpse of Indian society as well as our educational system brings to focus its bipolar contradictions -- poverty amidst plenty, skyscrapers versus slums, tradition versus modernity, spirituality versus religious intolerance, and the list goes on. A paradoxical fact facing the education system is the existence of some of the best educational institutions on par with world standards (IITs, IIMs et al) and the simultaneous presence of the largest number of illiterates (over 300 million) in the world.

The IITs were placed 50<sup>th</sup> in the world and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the field of Engineering (next only to MIT) by Times Higher World University Rankings. On the other side, out of every three ‘out-of-school children’ in the world, one resides in India. Fewer than 40 percent of adolescents in India attend secondary school. Besides, only a quarter of Indian graduates, according to one estimate, are ‘employable’.

In the just concluded vacation, I had the satisfaction of doing my bit to the education system. On invitation, I and my team of facilitators, motivated and trained teachers and students in schools of coastal Karnataka and Kerala. While the teachers and students appreciated the participatory and creative methodology, we had the satisfaction of igniting a few sparks before the commencement of a new academic year. Needless to add, more has to be done if ‘formation’ and not just ‘information’ is the motto, and fun in learning and creativity is the goal. Any takers!

10. It was resolved to put a proposal in the AGM to amend the Bye-Laws regarding the AGM date.
11. Prof. S. Sadashiva Rao informed the house that many colleges do not pay leave salary to the management staff during April, May and June Vacations. University should take the initiative to look into this matter.
12. P.U. Re-deployment issue was discussed in the meeting. Prof. A.M. Narahari gave the details of recent developments in this regard.
13. Members expressed their concern about the delay in placements and other matters in J.D. Office. They requested the President to follow up this matter.
14. Prof. A.M. Narahari, President of FUCTAK proposed to felicitate Sri. Aravinda Limbavali, Minister for Higher Education, Sri. A.S. Srikanth, Secretary to Government of Karnataka for Higher Education and Dr. N. Nagambika Devi, Commissioner for Collegiate Education on the occasion of AMUCT Annual Convention , which was unanimously seconded by the house.
15. Prof. Purushothama. K.V., General Secretary of AMUCT appealed the members to attend the AGM in large number and make the convention a grand success. He proposed the vote of thanks and meeting was adjourned.



The AGM of FUCTAK was held at PES college, Mandya on 03, May 2009. Prof. Joselyn Lobo and Prof. Purushothama K V attended the meeting.

#### **AIFUCTO CONFERENCE**

The three days 26<sup>th</sup> AIFUCTO Conference was held at Jnanajyothi Auditorium, Central College, Bangalore. The Academic conference held on the theme of "Inclusive Education" from October 16-19, 2008 in the same venue. More than 2000 delegates participated from all over the country. The Conference was organised by BUCTA and KGCTA under the aegis of FUCTAK and its eight constituent units. Along with President and Secretary 20 members from our unit participated in this conference.

#### **EDUCATION ADALAT**

To speed up pending cases of both teaching and non-teaching staff, the education department conducted three Adalats. AMUCT has been taking more concern on UGC Pay Scale issues. Unit has been in constant touch with FUCTAK and AIFUCTO to get latest developments at the National and State Level.

## KEY AREAS OF CONCERN

Though we tried our best, there are issues which need our attention in the course of time. Some of the issues which need immediate attention are:

1. Pending placements\ fixation problems.
2. Total redeployment of PU Deputed teachers.
3. Regularization of temporary teachers and fixation of equal pay to them.

5. Computerization of degree marks cards.
6. Grant-in-aid for newly introduced compulsory subjects –Constitution of India, Human Rights, Gender Equity and Environment.

Besides the interest earned on Seminar Fund Investment of Rs. 1,04,000.00 is utilised for organising workshops, and seminars on various vital Academic issues


The well equipped AMUCT office is being regularly utilised for meetings of AMUCT Managing Council, AMUCT Trust and for academic activities of various subject associations.

## AUDITOR'S REPORT

1. 3. We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for our audit. In our opinion, proper books of account have been kept as required by law, so far as appears from our examination of the books and the above mentioned Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account are in agreement therewith.
4. In our opinion, the Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account dealt with by this report comply with the requirement of the Accounting Standards.
5. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Balance Sheet and the Income & Expenditure Account together with the notes thereon, give in the prescribed manner, the information required and also give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India,




