NOTIFICATION Towns

The draft of the Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment for the posts of Principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2018 which the Government of Karnataka proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act No.14 of 1990), is hereby published as required by clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 3 of the said Act, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after expiry of fifteen days from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received by the State Government from any person with respect to the said draft before the expiry of the period specified above will be considered by the State Government. Objections and Suggestions may be addressed to the Principal Secretary to Government, Education Department (Higher Education), M.S. Building, Bangalore – 560 001.

DRAFT RULES

- 1. Title, commencement and Application.- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of the post of Principal (UG) (Special) Rules, 2018.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment) Rules 2008, the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 or any other rules governing recruitment to the post of principal (U.G) in the



department of collegiate education made or deemed to have been made, under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990). The provisions of these rules shall apply to direct recruitment vacancies of the posts of principal (UG) in the Collegiate Education Department, existing as on the date of commencement of these rules:

Provided that, these rules shall not apply for more than one recruitment.

- 2. Definitions.-(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "Appointing Authority" means the Government of Karnataka;
 - (b) "Appendix" means appendix appended to these rules;
 - (c) "Government First Grade College (UG)" means Degree College established and maintained by State Government and identified from time to time as UG College;
 - (d) "Principal (UG)" means the post of Principal in the Government First Grade College (UG) or Principal in the Government Law College (UG) in the Karnataka State; as the case may be;
 - (e) "Selection" means selection in accordance with provisions of these rules by the Selection Authority; and
 - (f) "Selection Authority" means the Selection Authority constituted under rule 4.
- (2) Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meanings assigned to them in the Karnataka State Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977.
- **3. Qualification and Age.-** (1) No person shall be eligible for appointment as Principal (UG) under these rules unless he, -
 - (i) has a Master's degree in the concerned subject with at least fifty five percent marks or a relevant grade regarded as equivalent to fifty five percent wherever grading system is followed by a University established by law;
 - (ii) has Ph.D qualification in concerned or allied or relevant discipline with evidence of published work; and
 - (iii) is a Professor or Associate Professor with a total experience as full time faculty of fifteen years of teaching or research or administration in

any Government First Grade Colleges recognised or affiliated to universities of Karnataka drawing salary in UGC Payscale;

- (iv) has minimum score of Academic performance indicator (API) as notified by the State Government from time to time based on performance based Appraisal System (PBAS) format as developed by UGC specified in Appendix-I; and
 - (v) Must be a citizen of India.
- (2) No candidates shall qualify for the selection to the post of Principal (UG) unless he qualifies in a test in Karnataka language comprising of one paper carrying maximum of 150 marks and secures minimum of 50 marks in the said qualifying test regarding knowledge of Kannada:

Provided that, the Selection Authority may exempt a candidate from passing the Kannada language test, if the candidate has passed the S.S.L.C. examination or any equivalent examination or any examination higher than S.S.L.C. in which Kannada is the main language or second language or an optional subject (but not one of the subject in composite paper) or has passed in Kannada medium.

- **4. Constitution of Selection Authority.-** (1) There shall be a Selection Authority for selection of persons for appointment as Principal (UG) in Department of Collegiate Education under these rules.
- (2) The Selection Authority for selection to the post of Principal (UG) shall consist of following members, namely:-

1	Commissioner for Collegiate Education	Chairman
2	Director of Collegiate Education	Member Secretary
3	Senior most Joint Director of Collegiate Education	Member
4	Three experts, consisting of a professor and an accomplished educationist out of a Panel of six experts approved by the Government as recommended by Commissioner of Collegiate Education	Members

Provided that, one out of 03 subject experts shall represent among the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes or Minority or Women or Differently-abled categories.

- (3) The quorum for a meeting of the Selection Authority shall be four members of whom at least two shall be experts.
- **5. Notification of Vacancies.-** Appointing Authority shall intimate the vacancies to be filled under these rules to the Selection Authority as per reservation policy applicable to direct recruitment issued by Government from time to time.
- 6. Inviting Applications.- The Selection Authority shall after receipt of intimation of vacancies to be filled invite applications in the form specified by it from all eligible candidates by giving wide publicity in at least three leading Kannada newspapers and three leading English newspapers having wide circulation in the State. The advertisement shall also indicate the conditions of eligibility, the method of selection applicable, provisional number of vacancies to be filled and their classifications according to reservation policy of the State.
- 7. Mode of Selection.- (1) After the expiry of the last day for submitting application, the Selection Authority shall consider the applicants who have fulfilled qualifications specified in rule 3 for selection under these rules and prepare the merit list of applicants eligible for interview on the basis of the aggregate percentage of marks secured in the qualifications specified in clauses (i) to (iv) of sub-rule (1) of rule 3 and in the manner specified in items A to C of Appendix-2:

Provided that, if two or more candidates secure equal percentage of marks in qualification specified in sub-rule (1), the order of merit of such candidates shall be fixed on the basis of their age, the person older in age being placed higher in the order of the merit.



- (2) Subject to reservation policy of the State, the Selection Authority shall prepare a list of names of candidates eligible for interview in ratio of 1:3 in relation to the vacancies intimated in rule 5.
- (3) The candidates whose name appears in the merit list prepared under sub-rule (2), shall be called for interview conducted by Selection Authority.
- 8. Mode of Interview.- (1) The Selection Authority shall conduct interview of those candidates whose name appear in merit list prepared under sub-rule (1) and (2) of rule 7, for 10 percentage of marks.
- (2) The Selection Authority shall award percentage of marks under each criterion of interview as per the enumeration given in item (D), of Appendix-2.
- **9. List of Selected Candidates.-** (1) The Selection Authority shall, prepare a final list of persons selected equal to the number of vacancies notified and arranged in the order of merit, the merit being determined on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in criteria for selection an enumerated in rule 7 and 8.
- (2) In preparing the list under sub-rule (1), the Selection Authority shall follow the orders issued by the State Government from time to time in the matter of reservation of appointments and posts, for the persons belonging to Scheduled Castes, Schedules Tribes, Other Backward Classes and 371(J) of Constitution of India.
- (3) The Selection Authority shall also prepare an additional list of such candidates not included in the main list prepared under sub-rule (1), the number of candidates to be included in the additional list shall be as far as possible ten percent of the number of candidates in each of the reservation categories (horizontal and vertical) in the list under sub-rule(1). There shall be at least one candidate in the additional list belonging to each of the reservation categories (horizontal and vertical) represented in the list

under sub-rule (1). If a candidate whose name is included in the list under sub-rule (1) fails to report for duty within the prescribed period, then a candidate belonging to the same reservation category as of the candidate who failed to report for duty shall be appointed from the additional list.

- (4) The final selection list and additional list prepared under subrules (1) and (3), shall be published in the Karnataka Gazette and on the Notice Board or such other media as the selection authority may deem fit and in such manner, as the State Government may direct. The fact of selection shall be intimated to the candidates selected by the Selection authority and the list shall be valid till all the vacancies notified under these rules are filled up or until the expiry of the period if six months from the date of publication of the list prepared under sub-rule (1) and (3) whichever is earlier.
- 10. Appointment of Candidates.- (1) Candidates whose names are included in the lists prepared by the Selection Authority under rule 9 may be appointed by the Appointing Authority in the vacancies in the order in which the names are found in the final selection list after satisfying itself after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that each of the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment.
- (2) Inclusion of the name of a candidate in the list published under sub-rule (4) of rule 9 shall not confer any right of appointment to the candidate.
- (3) Service rendered in Government Colleges as Professors or Associate Professors of those appointed as Principals (UG) shall be reckoned for purpose of pay, leave and pension:

Provided that, those who have submitted applications without obtaining permission or no objection certificate from the competent authority shall not be eligible for reckoning of service rendered as Professors or Associate Professors for purpose of pay, leave and pension.

11. Tenure of Candidates.- (1) The tenure of those candidates to whom appointment order is issued under rule 10 shall be five years with

eligibility for reappointment for one more term only after a similar selection process:

Provided that, those candidates who have completed the tenure of five years or one more term of five years tenure shall have right to continue as Professors or Associate Professors in their respective colleges where they were serving before appointment till attaining the age superannuation.

Provided further that, those who appointed as Principal (UG) and have attained the age of more than fifty five years shall retire from service on the day he attains the age of superannuation prescribed by State Government from time to time and for no reason he shall be continued in the service after the date of superannuation.

- (2) Associate Professors or Professors appointed as Principal (UG) shall be liable for criminal or disciplinary proceedings in case of either misappropriation of funds allocated to the colleges by the State Government, or for misconduct during his tenure.
- 12. Application of other rules.- All rules governing the conditions of service of Government Servant made or deemed to have been made under the provisions of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) shall apply to the persons appointed as Principal (UG) under these rules.

- (v) Papers with impact factor above 10 by 25 points.

The API for joint publications shall be calculated in the following manner of the total score for relevant category of publication by the concerned teacher, the First and Principal/corresponding Author/Supervisor/Mentor who share equally 70% of the total points and remaining 30% would be shared equally by all other authors.
